The Saddlebrooke Silversmiths and Lapidary Club is an organization whose members design and hand fabricate art jewelry primarily from silver, gold, and copper. Our lapidarians create beautiful cabochons and faceted stones from rough rock, in addition to preparing geological collector specimens. Many members fabricate original, one-of-a-kind earrings, pendants, necklaces, bracelets, and belt buckles using various jewelry techniques such as vacuum and sand casting, enameling, etching, and forging. We have one of the finest metal studios in the Arizona.

Visit our studio in the Turquoise room at the Mountain View Craft Center to see the equipment and meet members on any Wednesday or Friday between 9AM and 4PM.

If you would like to learn silversmithing for making jewelry, we offer instructional classes in basic metalsmithing. Classes are held periodically throughout the year, and a sign-up sheet is posted on the bulletin board in the studio. All residents of Saddlebrooke are welcome, and eligible to join the club. Yearly dues are \$45.00.
