



Welcome To The SaddleBrooke Pottery Club Site

The Pottery Club is composed of members who are interested in making hand-built or wheel-thrown ceramic pieces. Great enjoyment is derived by club members who create decorative sculptures, wall hangings, tiles, lanterns and various pieces that are both beautiful and functional. Two rooms (Room # 1 & # 2) are available to the Pottery Club that is located in the SaddleBrooke Arts and Crafts Center. Pottery Club members may use the rooms each day of the week from 7:30 AM to 9:00 PM.

Classes and workshops are offered to club members. The Pottery Club facility is well equipped with a slab roller, clay extruders, potter's wheels, electric kilns, storage for personal tools and clay, a drying room, work tables and a wide array of tools and materials that may be used in making clay objects. The club also has a library of books, CD's and videos on all subjects related to the clay arts. All new members receive an orientation and information packet to acquaint them with club policies and procedures.

The fee to join the Pottery Club is \$20.00 for the first year (this includes a \$5.00 refundable key deposit) and \$15.00 per year thereafter. The fee entitles Pottery Club members use of the facilities and equipment, as well as access to a limited supply of glazes and tools for working with clay. An additional firing fee is charged for firing work in the kilns.

The Pottery Club has members with a wide range of skill and abilities, and provides an environment for sharing knowledge and techniques that are helpful to beginners as well as experienced potters.
